



## Federal Funding Opportunities

### **No Child Left Behind (NCLB)**

#### **Title I, Part A**

##### **Improving the Academic Achievement of the Disadvantaged, Basic Grants**

*Title I-A provides supplemental educational opportunities for disadvantaged children who are most at risk of failing to meet each state's challenging content and performance standards.*

#### **Title I, Part B, Subpart 1**

##### **Reading First State Grants**

*The primary purpose is to support the utilization of scientifically based reading research to implement comprehensive reading instruction for children in kindergarten through third grade.*

#### **Title II, Part A**

##### **Improving Teacher Quality State Grants**

*The purpose of this program is to increase student achievement through comprehensive district initiatives that focus on the preparation, training, recruitment, and retention of highly qualified educators.*

#### **Title II, Part D**

##### **Enhancing Education Through Technology State Grants**

*This program is intended to help districts improve student achievement through the use of technology in their schools. It is also designed to assist students in becoming technologically literate by the end of eighth grade. Lastly, it encourages high quality professional development that uses research-based instructional strategies to effectively integrate technology into instruction.*

#### **Title III**

##### **English Language Acquisition: State Formula Grant Program**

*This program assists school districts in teaching English to Limited English Proficient students and in helping these students meet the same challenging state standards required of all students.*

#### **Title V, Part A**

##### **Innovative Programs State Grants**

*Federal Innovative Program grants fund a wide range of activities that support education reform efforts: innovation based on scientific research; the purchase of instructional, library, and media materials; and the implementation of programs to improve school, student, and teacher performance.*

#### **Flexibility**

*Transferability is the flexibility authority in NCLB that gives districts the ability to transfer a portion of the funding they receive—by formula under certain Federal programs—to allocations under other programs. This enables districts to more effectively address specifically identified programmatic needs. Transferability provides districts with unprecedented flexibility in targeting Federal resources to meet the needs of all children.*



### **Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)**

#### **IDEA, Part B**

##### **Assistance for Education of All Children with Disabilities**

*The primary purpose is to ensure that all students with disabilities have available to them a free, appropriate education which includes special education and any related services to meet their unique needs.*
